9th	Completion of Service Learning Project; mentoring activities of 8 th grade PEAK Achievers	\$500	Earned by <u>all</u> PEAK Achievers for continuing education after graduating high school
10th	Educational Summer Camp – one fun-filled week in the dorms at the Johnson Wales Denver campus	Free Attendance	Available to <u>every</u> PEAK Achiever between their sophomore and junior year
11th	Paid Professional Work Internship; these employment opportunities are awarded on merit, with no restrictions on use of the earnings	\$1500	Five (5) part-time positions are funded each summer beginning in 2018 and are awarded on a competitive basis – <i>see criteria below</i>
12th	4-year College Scholarship – paid in four \$2500 annual installments	\$10,000	Awarded to <u>one</u> graduating high school senior every academic year beginning in 2019 – <i>see criteria below</i>
